**Our Business**

**Our approach to Slavery and Human Trafficking**

At all levels of management, sensitivity and awareness of such activity is paramount when liaising with our suppliers both in the UK and Europe.

**Due Diligence to counter Slavery & Human Trafficking**

- All our employees are based within our UK head office, and none are permanently operating outside of the UK so senior management are trained and able to closely monitor the situation and status of our employees.
- When recruiting staff, this is undertaken directly by a permanent member of Brital staff. Agencies are only used to identify candidates and face to face interviews are undertaken by trained Brital employees to ensure the potential employee has proper reason to work within the UK and is doing so voluntarily.
- All suppliers are selected by Brital management and have to operate to audited standards. This approach ensures there are no practices taking place that contravene our own policy relating to Slavery & Human Trafficking.

This statement is made in relation to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes the company's slavery and human trafficking statement for the current financial year 2023/2024 ending 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024.
